

Invest in communities— not jails and prisons.

Connecticut is spending billions every year to arrest and incarcerate predominantly low-income, Black, and Latinx people. At the same time, many people cannot find affordable housing, cancer patients must set up GoFundMe pages for their medical care, and teachers and students are stuck holding fundraisers to buy basic school supplies.

This is wrong. But we can fix it. Connecticut must:

 **CUT** the number of people detained in CT jails and prisons. Cut the budgets used for caging people.

 **SHUT** down jails and prisons.

 **INVEST** in real community safety: housing, health care, education, jobs.
